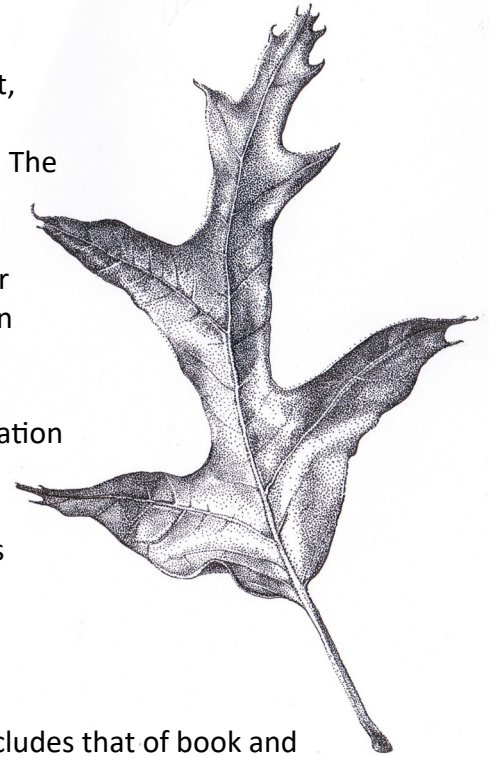


Pen & Ink PNBA Virtual 2-Day Workshop with Kathy Schermer-Gramm

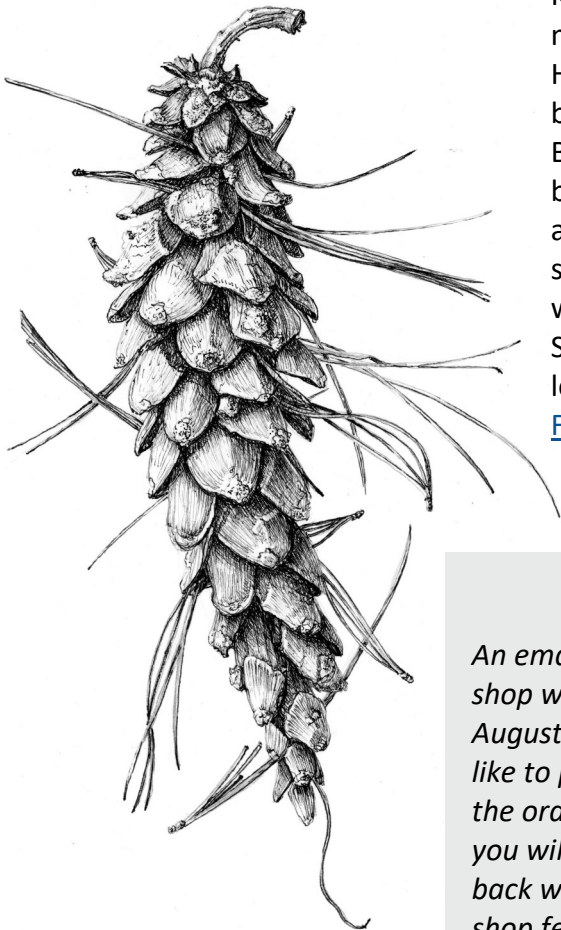
September 28 & October 5 from 9 AM to 12:30 PM PDT

We hope you will join us for our two-day fall workshop with botanical artist, Kathy Schermer-Gramm. This workshop is designed as an exploration of different pen and ink techniques to be used in depicting botanical subjects. The first Saturday session will focus on dip pen exercises that combine loose linework with various marks and strokes to best describe the textures of a woody subject. For the second session we will switch to using technical or micron/multiliner tip pens for a more refined stipple technique to use when developing a full tonal study of a leaf.

Students will be given supplemental handouts and pre-recorded demonstration videos to go along with the live Zoom meetings. The workshop sessions are scheduled on two consecutive Saturdays to provide more time to complete exercises. Participants will have the option to post their drawings to the easy-to-use Padlet online platform to receive individual feedback. Recordings of the workshop sessions will be available for four weeks. This workshop is suitable for all skill levels



Kathy Schermer-Gramm's career includes that of book and magazine illustrator, nature educator, and college art professor. Her lovely botanical art focusing on edibles and Southeastern flora began while she was enrolled in the North Carolina Botanical Garden's Botanical Art and Illustration Certification Program. Kathy has taught botanical art internationally online and at the garden since 2012. Her art work has been juried into the ASBA's Abundant Future Exhibition, several ASBA Annual Internationals, *Plantae* as well as other international exhibitions.
